The Alberta Injury Control Strategy Advisory Committee serves in an advisory capacity offering perspectives from a range of constituencies to provide periodic conceptual or big picture input, observations and recommendations related to moving the Alberta Injury Control Strategy forward.

The Advisory Committee is comprised of 20 – 30 visionary, forward-thinking, team players who are familiar with and support the Alberta Injury Control Strategy; are committed to and enthusiastic about moving the Strategy forward; and are willing and available to commit to the terms of the Advisory Committee. Others may be invited by the Advisory Committee to participate as resource persons for certain meetings or periods of time to bring specific expertise or information to the Committee. The Committee, which generally meets quarterly, has two co-chairs. Requests to attend a meeting as a guest or observer by anyone outside the Advisory Committee membership should be made to the Committee co-chairs.
